Falling Away-By Hayden Potter

Therefore, let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.-1 Corinthians 10:12

Forming a relationship takes time and will power. We have to spend time getting to know the person, then after time and through perseverance, a close friendship is formed. But if we don't maintain our relationships and if we begin to neglect the people we've bonded with, we will lose connection with them. The very same thing goes for our relationship with God.

We are told that "whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it-not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it-they will be blessed in what they do" (Jms 1:25). Here we are clearly told we must "continue" in God's law, and not "forget" what we have heard. For if we forget and begin to draw back from God and His law, we put ourselves in danger, because the Lord says "the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him" (Heb 10:38).

Therefore we must always be on our guard, making sure that we stand firm in the faith. Knowing our enemy the devil "prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour" (1 Pet 5:8), but through constant fellowship with God we can overcome him. In fact, when our relationship with God is strong, we can overcome anything. Going to Him in prayer on all occasions, knowing that "He listens to the godly person who does his will" (John 9:31).
