Ladies Lunch and Meeting: Will be Sunday January 29th after morning services (Ladies only).

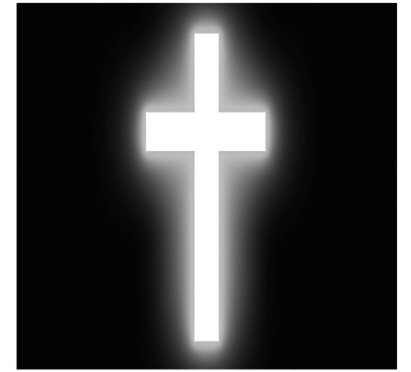
Duty Sign-Ups: Check the glass wall so sign up for duties.

The Conversion of Paul- By Ron Boatwright

In the book of Acts we have the account of the conversion of the apostle Paul. In Acts chapter 9, Paul is traveling on the road up to Damascus to persecute Christians. The Lord appears to Paul on the road and strikes him blind. In verse 6 Paul asks, "Lord what do you want me to do? Then the Lord said to him, Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do." The Lord did not tell Paul what he must do, but that someone in the city would tell him "what you must do".

As Paul recounts this story a man named Ananias, came to him, taught him, and told him in Acts 22:16, "And now why are you waiting? Arise, and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord." Paul was not saved three days earlier while on the road to Damascus. Paul up to this point was still lost, because he still had all his sins that needed to be washed away. Paul still had a sin problem. Obedience to the Lord's command to be baptized was necessary to wash away Paul's sins. Man cannot devise his own plan as to how his sins are forgiven. We must submit to the plan of salvation which God graciously offers.
