Eyes Looking Home

On day six of the ill-fated Apollo 13 mission, the astronauts needed to make a critical course correction. If they failed, they would be unable to return to earth. To conserve power, they had shut down the computer on board that steered the craft, the question became, how do we steer?

Astronaut Jim Lovell determined that if they could keep a fixed point in space in view through their tiny window, they could steer the craft manually. The focal point, earth, Home.

For 39 tense seconds Lovell kept focus on earth as the boosters burned to make the course correction. By not losing sight the astronauts avoided disaster and returned home safely as heroes.
