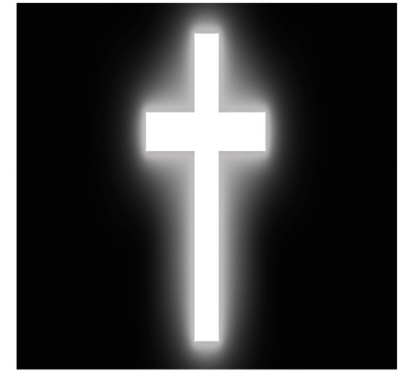
Educational Evangelism: Training for Tutoring will be November 6th at 10 at JW Sam Elementary. If you are still interested in serving in this capacity let Paul know.
