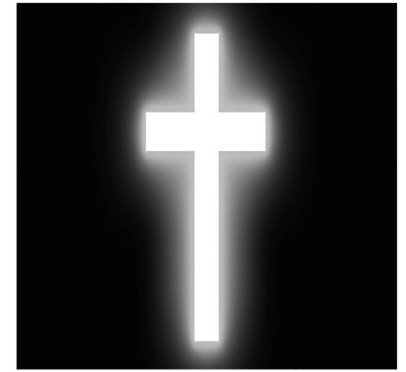
Congrats to the VanMeter Family: on the Birth of a Granddaughter (and niece) Ta'mya ! Keep mom dad and baby in your prayers

**Social Media Challenge: By Jack Wilkie**

John Piper once wrote that “One of the great uses of Twitter and Facebook will be to prove at the Last Day that prayerlessness was not from lack of time.” Every time I read that quote it steps all over my toes, and I feel pretty safe in saying I'm not the only one. With so many things competing for our attention these days, it's impossibly easy for Bible study and prayer to get shoved to the back burner. God calls us to “redeem the time” (Ephesians 5:16), and we're reminded that a wise person numbers their days (Psalm 90:12). God calls us to be intentional about the way we live our days, and for many of us that means making a change in the way we're currently living.

So, here's our challenge: pick what you feel takes up the most of your spare time – whether social media, game apps, video games, TV, whatever fits the bill for you – and track your time spent on it for a week. Then next week commit to using half of that time to pray or study.
