My Lord and My God By Paul Walvoord

John 20:24-29: But Thomas (who was called the Twin or Didymus), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. Therefore, the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."

A week later his disciples were again in the house and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my god!"

Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

Thomas saw Jesus. He walked with Jesus, talked with Jesus. They had conversations around the table. He was there for the Passover and the institution of the Lord's Supper. He saw Jesus betrayed. Thomas saw him Resurrected.

But I have not seen Jesus. I have not seen those scars in hands, feet and side. I have never spoken to him. Even though I have seen with my eyes nor heard with my ears the actual person of Jesus, yet because of my belief- based on mountain of Christian evidence- I am blessed. Despite my disadvantages in coming to believe- I know he lives, reigns over all creation and will come again.
