Senior Honor Night: Will be the evening of Sunday May 7th. Raven Lay and Austin Battles are graduating this year!

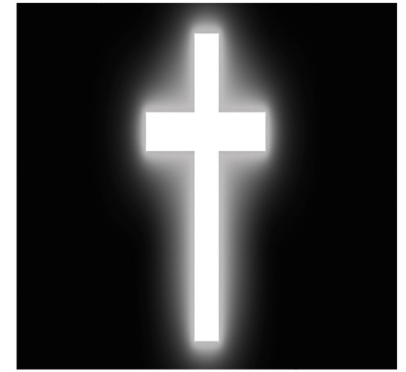

Questions for God By Paul Walvoord

Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said: "Who is this who darkens counsel. By words without knowledge? Now prepare yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer Me. "Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. Who determined its measurements? Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? To what were its foundations fastened? Or who laid its cornerstone, When the morning stars sang together, And all the sons of God shouted for joy? -Job 38:1-7 NKJV

Do we ever go through hard times and blame God for all of our misfortunes? Do we ever talk to God and ask him why he allows all sorts of unfortunate events to occur in our lives. Have you ever questioned God about the death of a near and dear family member or perhaps we asked God why you no longer have a job? Well if you have asked God any of these questions; you are not alone.

Job asked God many a great many questions such as "Why did I not die at birth? In Job 3:11, and "Why is light given to him who is in misery. And life to the bitter of soul" Job 3:20; and "Why do the wicked live and become old, Yes, become mighty in power?" Job 21:7. Have you ever asked similar questions, well I have.
