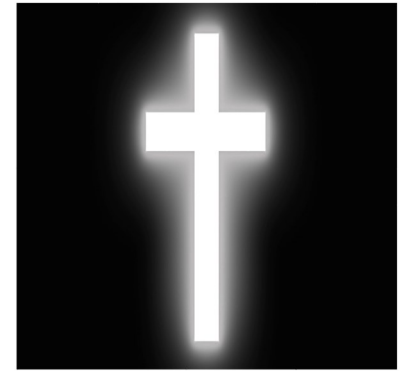
No Services: On the Wednesday Evening of July 4th.
