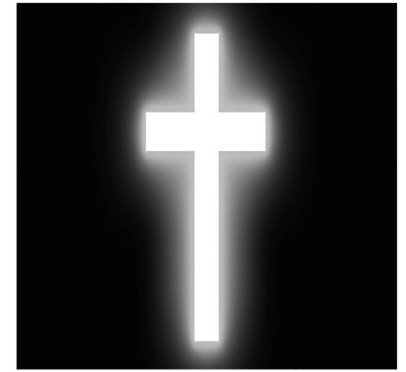
Hope Harbor: Disc Golf Tournament with our annual Fish Fry/Auction on September 30th

Frank Capra, who directed *It's a Wonderful Life*, was asked years ago about the central message of his classic film. He responded, "I believe the real message is this: that under the sun, nothing is insignificant to God."
