Change Cans: Pick up your Hope Harbor Change Cans! And Fill 'em up!

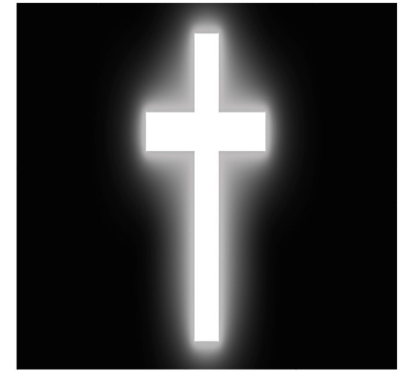
Ladies Day: Is set for Saturday August 27th. It will be here at the building at 5:00.
